ORDER AFTER HEARING


Hearing Held. For the reasons stated on the record, the Court GRANTED the Motion to Stay Pre-Trial Discovery and extended the October 9, 2012 Case Management Order (Docket Item No. 76) as follows:

1. Fact Discovery cutoff off July 3, 2013
2. Expert Discovery cutoff August 23, 2013
3. Last Date for Filing Dispositive Motions September 6, 2013
4. Preliminary Pretrial Conference set for September 20, 2013 at 11:00 AM
5. Joint Preliminary Pretrial Conference statement due September 10, 2013
6. Defendant Feathers to respond to outstanding discovery by March 8, 2013

For the reasons stated on the record, as to the Motion for Relief for Claims Bar Date and Approval of Claim Forms (Docket Item No. 132), the Court GRANTS the motion as follows:

1. The Court approves the claim forms as previous attachments "A", "B", and "C" to Docket Item No. 116 for distribution.
2. Claims Bar deadline May 10, 2013.
3. Notice shall be as follows:
 - (A) Mail
 - (B) Receiver's Website
 - (C) Publication in the San Francisco Chronicle, Wall Street Journal and San Jose Mercury News
4. All proof of claims shall be received by the Receiver.

For the reasons stated on the record as to the Status re Receiver's Fourth Interim Report and Receiver's Preliminary Forensic Accounting Report and Petition for Instruction (Docket Item Nos. 167, 168), the Court continues the Receiver's forensic accounting and interim status reporting to the Court.
